Travel Advisory

14 days mandatory quarantine for travellers from India upon arrival in Turkey

Indian nationals intending to travel to Turkey are advised to carefully note the following:

- Turkey has imposed a 14 day mandatory quarantine upon arrival in the country, as per the quarantine rules announced by the Turkish Government on July 31, 2021, which came into effect from 2100 hrs on July 31 and shall be valid till 2100 hrs till August 31, 2021.
- All passengers of 06 years and older traveling from India, or have been to India
 in the last 14 days must submit a negative PCR test result taken within 72 hours
 prior to arrival.
- All such passengers shall be subjected to mandatory 14 days quarantine at hotels determined by the governorships. This is irrespective of the negative RT-PCR or Vaccination record of the individuals.
- If the PCR test result to be made at the end of the 14th day of quarantine is negative, the quarantine measures will be terminated.
- Expenses for accommodation and transfer from airports have to be borne
 by the passengers concerned. The hotel charges are required to be paid
 before arriving in Turkey. Those who cannot prove that they have made the
 necessary payments to stay at the identified hotels will not be allowed to
 board the flight.

- It may be noted that hotel rates are stated to be approximately Euros 200 per night per person (including children), payable in advance. In other words, for a family of four (two adults and two children) Euro 11,200 approximately would be required to be paid before boarding the flight for the 14 day mandatory quarantine period on arrival in Turkey.
- In view of the above, Indian nationals are advised to fully familiarize themselves with the above rules related to travel to Turkey from India and make an informed choice on their travel to Turkey under the present circumstances.
